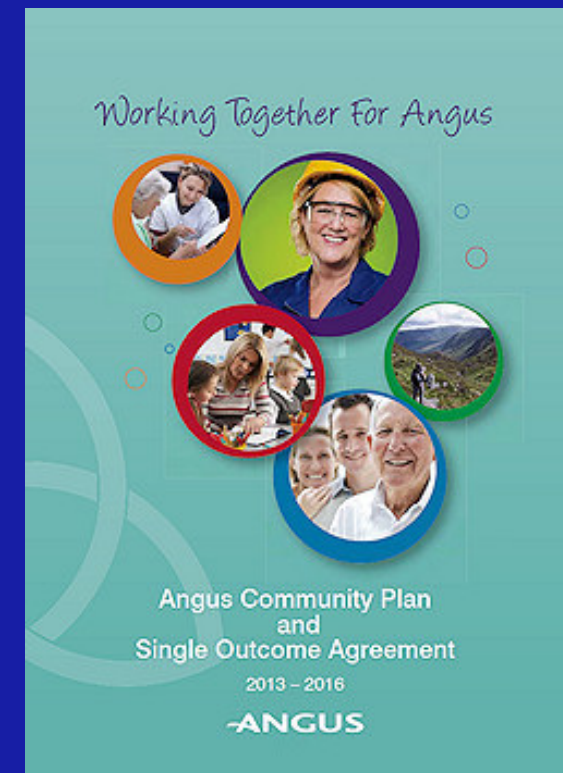
Where we're at

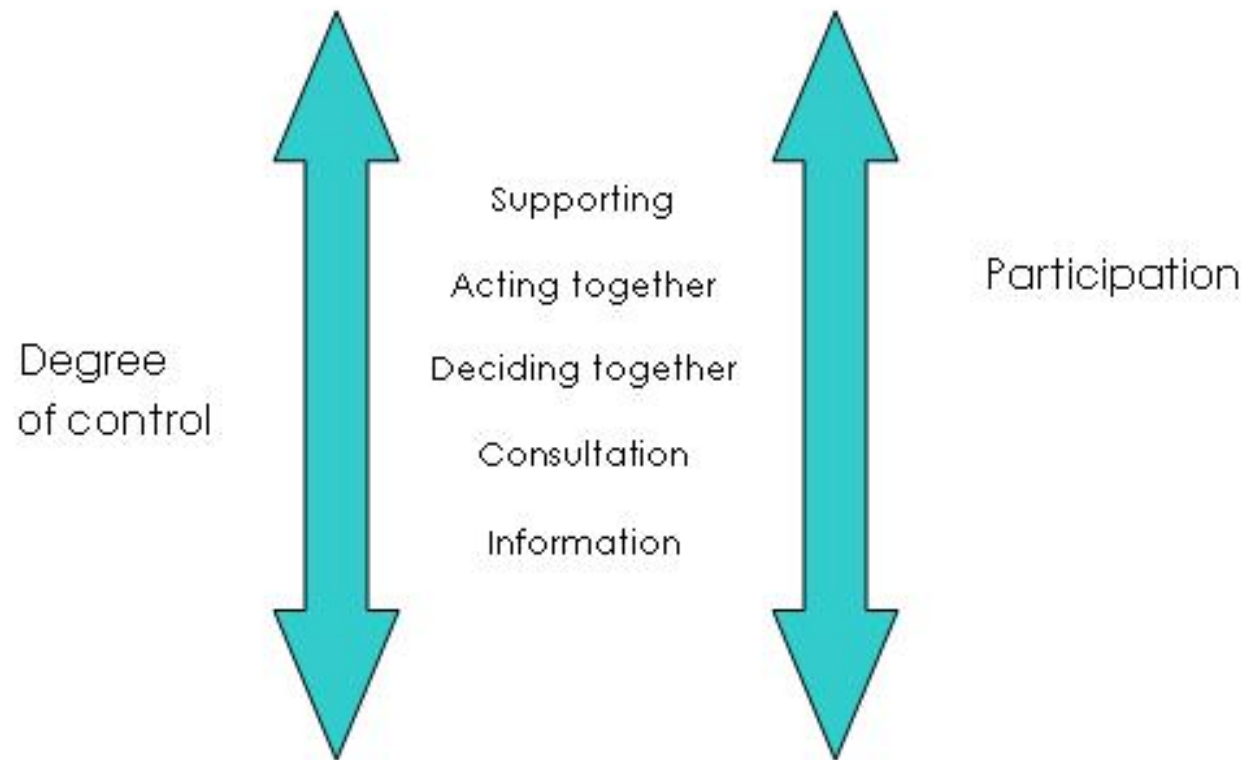
Angus Council is committed to supporting Community Councils. Together, we can achieve the best possible outcomes for Angus communities.
